

Green-headed Coneflower

(Rudbeckia laciniata)



Sun Exposure: full sun to partial shade

Height: 5 – 8 ft.

Bloom Season: summer/autumn

Seed Season: autumn

Wildlife: Butterflies eat the nectar, Bees eat nectar and pollen
Birds eat the seeds

Fun Facts: Cut back mid-season for shorter plants.

Native Americans used coneflowers to make yellow and orange dyes
