Sun Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Height: 1 – 1 ½ ft.

Bloom Season: Summer

Soil: Drought tolerant, high humidity and over watering can cause rot

Foliage: Silvery green leaves

Wildlife: Deer and rabbit resistance

Fun Fact: Lamb's ear has soft, velvety leaves and gets its name from

the leaf shape and texture.
