

# Purple Coneflower

(Echinacea purpurea)



**Sun Exposure:** full sun to partial shade

**Height:** 2 - 4 ft.

**Bloom Season:** summer

**Seed Season:** late summer/autumn

**Wildlife:** Butterflies eat the nectar

Bees eat nectar and pollen

Birds eat the seeds

**Fun Facts:** Purple Coneflower was used by Native Americans to treat everything from snakebites to pain relief to coughs. We still use this flower for medicinal purposes today.
