Purple Coneflower

(Echinacea purpurea)



Sun Exposure: full sun to partial shade

Height: 2 - 4 ft.

Bloom Season: summer

Seed Season: late summer/autumn **Wildlife:** Butterflies eat the nectar

Bees eat nectar and pollen

Birds eat the seeds

Fun Facts: Purple Coneflower was used by Native Americans to treat everything from snakebites to pain relief to coughs. We still use this flower for medicinal purposes today.
